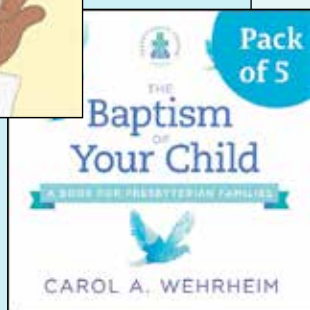
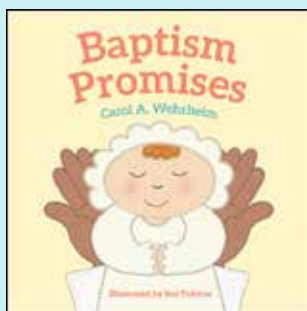

FEASTING on the WORD

CURRICULUM

Feasting on the Word Curriculum invites learners into the rhythm of the church year using a solid biblical and theological base for teachers. It is adaptable to various settings and learning styles, with multiple options for format, age-level combinations. Each session starts with a common, lectionary-based Bible passage for all age levels, making it easy for families to learn and live out their faith together. This approach, along with our unique resource for pastors and worship planners, *Joining the Feast*, provides intentional connections between education and worship. *Joining the Feast* also includes weekly children's bulletins and stories for children during worship. Children's age levels are enhanced by a supplementary music CD, creative color packs, and a variety of activities to stimulate learning. You can choose between downloadable and printed formats of the curriculum.

In addition to being adaptable to a variety of learning settings and teaching styles, this innovative resource asks four questions for each biblical passage to prepare teachers and shape each lesson: What? Where? So What? Now What?

WHAT?

Necessary information about backgrounds and meanings of Scripture is essential to understanding. This section asks "what?" are the essential things to know about the contexts, language, and settings of the biblical passage.



WHERE?

To understand the meanings of passages, we also need to ask "Where?" Where is God in this passage? Where are God's will and activities being expressed? These theological questions about where God's word comes to us in the passage are significant.



SO WHAT?

The implications of the passage for our Christian lives make the biblical passage come alive. We ask, "So what?" What does this passage mean to me? What does it mean for my relationship with God and other people?



NOW WHAT?

Biblical passages shape our understanding of the church and how we live in the world, connecting us to the needs of others and God's will for us. So we ask, "Now what?" Prompting us to reflect on how we—and the church—can live out what the passage is saying.



Is It for Your Church?

“킹덤 라이프”는 성경 전체를 관통하는 핵심 주제이며 예수님의 공생애 사역의 핵심이었던 ‘하나님 나라’의 백성으로 살아가기 위해 배우고, 배운 말씀을 훈련하는데 도움을 주는 것에 초점이 맞춰져 있다. 방법은 인도자가 일방적으로 가르치는 교수식이 아니라, 참가자들에게 계속해서 질문을 던짐으로써 자신의 삶을 함께 나누게 하는 나눔식이다. 말씀에 기초한 생각들을 서로 나누는 가운데 깨달음을 얻고, 깨달은 바를 실천해 나감으로써 하나님 나라 백성답게 변화되어 가면서 하나님 나라를 확장해 가도록 돕는 것이 “킹덤 라이프”가 지향하는 목표이다.
